## NQT and Early Careers Offer 2020 - 2021

Date	Session Content
Wednesday 23rd September	<b><u>Managing behaviour</u></b> Explore key elements including building relationships, the power of positive praise, maintaining consistent routines, standards and approaches and using your school sanction/reward policy.
Tuesday 13th October	<b><u>Manageable marking</u></b> Investigate useful approaches and different types of feedback, discover ways to prioritize, work smart and meet your school policy and expectations.
Tuesday 10th November	<b><u>How pupils learn</u></b> With your growing classroom experiences, revise and develop your knowledge of how pupils learn best including the science of cognitive load, long term and working memory, retrieval practice and sequencing.
Wednesday 9th December	<b><u>Fostering learning behaviours</u></b> Consider the research and practices that best support you to set high expectations, ensure individual challenge and support and enable pupil development of perseverance, creativity, kindness and hope.
Tuesday 12th January	<b><u>Classroom Practice</u></b> Develop your teaching expertise further with this session exploring planning and sequencing, developing questioning and promoting oracy within your classroom.
Wednesday 10th February	<b><u>Effective assessment</u></b> Join this session to discover how to avoid assessment pitfalls, pinpoint prior knowledge and understanding, use assessment effectively to plan actions and feedback and develop scaffolding self and peer assessment.
Wednesday 24th February	<b><u>Classroom Practice</u></b> Develop your teaching practice further by exploring elements including modelling, scaffolding, lesson structures and grouping.
Tuesday 23rd February	<b><u>Coherent curriculum</u></b> Discuss those crucial elements that lead to a successful curriculum; subject knowledge, sequencing schemata, skills vs knowledge, fluency/application and cross curricular links.
Tuesday 20th April	<b><u>Adaptive teaching</u></b> Explore how to effectively identify pupil needs, adapting for success, differentiate by resource/lesson structure and facilitate effective adult support.
Wednesday 19th May	<b><u>Professional relationships</u></b> Discover ways to engaging in CPD/research and seek further challenge/development. Discuss ways to contribute to the wider school community, advice for communicating with parents and approaches to collaborating with colleagues.

The sessions take place from 4 - 5.30pm and will cost £20 per delegate.
